WISDOM, STRENGTH & BEAUTY...The Three Principal Supports of Masonry. What are these three things? The dictionary definitions are as follows:

Wisdom – Knowledge of what is true or right coupled with good judgment; scholarly knowledge or learning.

Strength – Bodily or muscular power, vigor; moral power, firmness or courage; amount, quantity, proportion, intensity; power of resisting force, strain or wear.

Beauty – A quality that is present in a thing or person giving intense aesthetic pleasure or deep satisfaction to the senses or mind; a person or thing that excels or is remarkable of its kind.

The recent two-day snow storm, over the President's Day weekend, gave me much time to contemplate. As I looked out of my windows as the storm was unfolding and intensifying, and as I viewed the prolonged television coverage of Mother Nature wielding her mighty scepter, it occurred to me the commonality that Mother Nature in all her glory and our three Principal Supports had.
