On December 1, 2004, Riverside Chapter – OES is having their Master Mason Night.

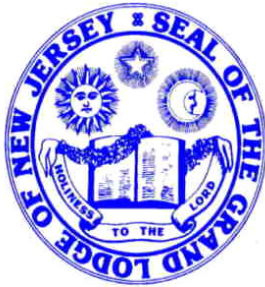
Beverly-Riverside Lodge is invited to attend an evening with the ladies. I hope you'll come out and support them. Together we can make something great even better.

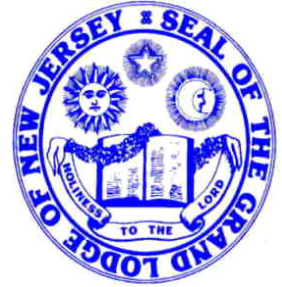

my head could reach a cloud,*

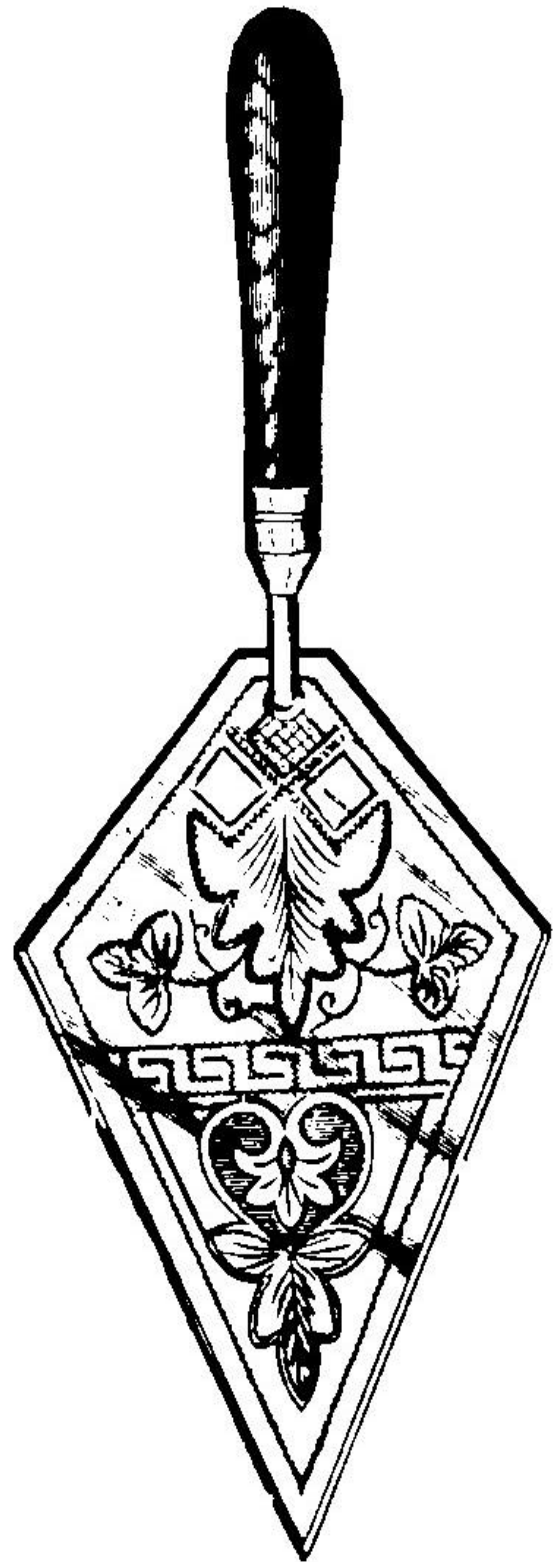
*I'm glad I had the courage
