On March 10, the audit committee suggested the dues should be raised. We receive \$3,700 in dues, but our expenses are around \$10,000 each year. The following motion was made and was read at the last three meetings.

MOTION; The dues shall be changed from \$44.50 to \$75.00 per year, and the lifetime membership will change from \$500 to \$750, starting in January 2009.
