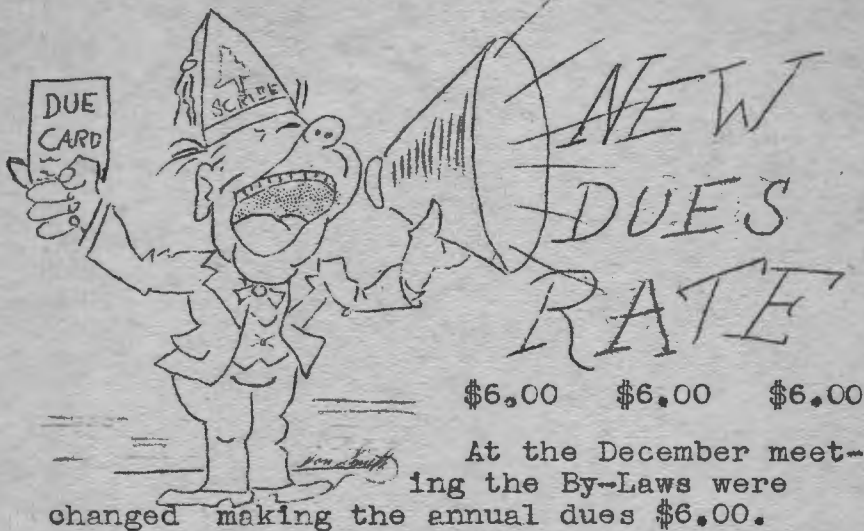


Greetings and a happy HELL'0 to the

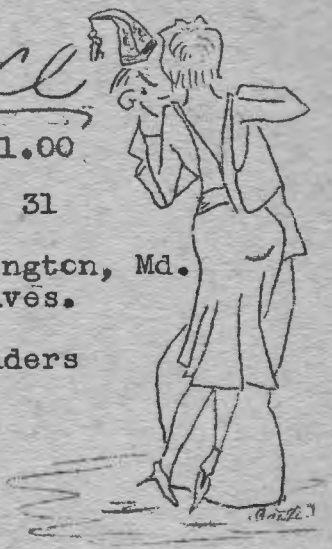

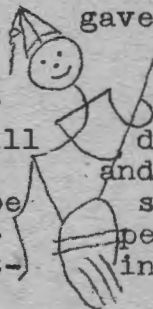
Yes, I guess everyone - almost-made a speech at the Installation of Officers. And they were all enjoyed! We all liked the one Myron made after he got to his little gavel. "
