Jack was charged with murder. Some testified that Jack held a grudge and it was premeditated. Because of his age, among other legal things, he received only ten years.

I heard his case in court, as I was there with another problem case. I really got to know him when he was in jail. He was considered a problem. He

would not take part in programs unless forced to. He was going downhill.

I conducted an eight-week counseling program. It was basically to show them how important a belief in a supreme being was and how this affected their life style.

One day, after five weeks into the program. I got a call from the jail chaplain. He told me Jack had requested sessions with him; he wanted to find Christ.

Jack's life changed completely. He now attended church service each Sunday; he went to the abuse programs voluntarily. He was social with the jail population.

Jack was given an early parole. The victim's family and many others were very upset about this. But this is the way the parole board works. It was up to Jack to prove the board had made the right decision.

Jack worked for me and lived with a local church family. I was very close to him for many months; to be sure he was on the right course.

Jack has been out of fail for over five years. He has never gone back on alcohol or narcotics. He was tested quite regularly, at my request, and because he was on parole. He has worked with youth, alcohol anonymous, and drug abuse clinics. He has given much of his time for this. He is considered a model citizen.

How much better for all, if some man had taken the time to be a real role model for him when he was very young. It took others many years of hard work to straighten the bent, and almost broken, tree. How much easier to train the twig.

The soul of a child is the loveliest flower That grows in the Garden of God.




