His appearance betrays him. To see him you would think he was a nobody. He is quiet and seems to be interested only in his personal life. How different he really is. Let's go back and see how "Tom" started up life's ladder.

He was from a middle class family , an only child. He went through law school and passed the bar. Tom married during his college days; it seemed a perfect marriage. Parties were a part of life. Booze flowed like water. Tom's law practice was booming. He was gaining wealth and counting the so-called important people as his friends.

There came a time when a lawyer was needed to help a fallen alcoholic with court cases involving money matters. Tom was approached and he almost laughed as he said he would not help. He left and his wife was near. She told how Tom had changed. His drinking was to excess and his personality was changed. Could I find help for him?

I came to ask Tom's help, and here his wife is asking my help. It was made clear that Tom could be helped if he wanted it. He must agree to the help offered. She talked to him, but he refused.

Tom's alcohol habit cost him much of his practice. His wife left. He finally went bankrupt. He tried to put up a front but finally he called for help. His first words were could I use him as an attorney in my business. The door was open to tell him no one including myself could use him for anything until he arrested the alcohol problem.

Tom said, "Please give me a job doing anything; but don't keep telling me to get help. I can't stop drinking." I brought him to tears when I mentioned his wife who was still wearing her heart on her sleeve for him. "Why not make her so very proud of you. Why not be a husband instead of a lost soul, almost useless," I said to him. Through his tears he said, "Let's get help." Tom was coughing and looked sick. I took him, with his consent, to our doctor. Tom had developed diabetes among other ailments.

Tom's wife came to his side and helped through many months of hospitalization. I would visit many times; he was always so appreciative. Tom was now a broken man, penniless; but for the first time, he wanted to find his God and make it back. He asked me to please stick with him and show him God's way. How strange this man, who a few years before laughed in my face when he was asked to help some other lost soul, now asks my help. I did stay beside him and got others involved. All of his former so-called friends had forgotten all about him.

When Tom was released from hospital care, he came out with an amputation. He lost a leg. He never got an artificial limb; he uses a crutch to this day. He will tell you he always used a crutch. First his crutch was alcohol; that led to his present wooden crutch. It's a great reminder he says.

Today, when there is need for a lawyer for someone who is a captive of alcohol, Tom is always there with no fee charged. He will call and say, "Today I helped one more and I hope God knows I'm trying."

Tom is once more a successful lawyer. His practice seems good. Now he goes with one leg, but he has the power of God with him. And his faithful wife. He recently had this verse framed and put on his wall:

"Let me be a little braver,

when temptation bids me waver, Let me strive a little harder to be all that I should be. Let me be a little meeker with the brother that is weaker. Let me think more of my people and a little less of me."

May God continue to bless Tom in his service to mankind.

Look at the Masthead page of each issue of the "ECHO" to be sure who they are and if you are listed, it is time for you to make note and be at our next meeting.




