He went on to say as how he felt ugly and dumb and even his stepmother said he was mentally unfit. (She had him puit in a mental hospital in the past but each time they released him) Then he went on as to how much he loved me and respected me, he thanked me for all I had done for him. I finally got to tell him, after all else failed, I said, "Ben, if you won't tell me where you are or see me let me say this. If you kill yourself I am going to feel that I let God down because your body belongs to him, not you. It's not yours to destroy. I surly will feel that I failed him. If you love me as you say and if you respect my advice then you can drive your car to the front steps of Spring Grove Hospital, where there is a no parking sign, leave your car and go in and admit yourself. 
