
**June 13th Executive meeting** at Allen's. Attendance was great and things were accomplished.

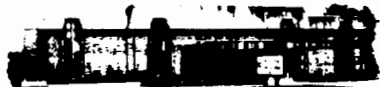

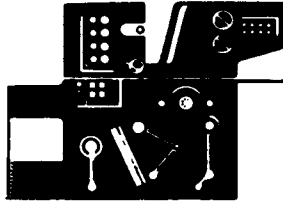

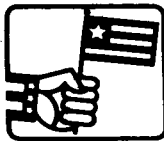
