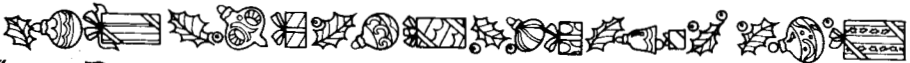

Charles Darwin, born in England in 1809, first studied to be a doctor of medicine and then to be a minister, but studied science. He wrote much about evolution and science, many of the time agreed with his work. He gave up his religious beliefs and regarded the Bible as a book of fairy tales. He often said the book of hebrews was the most fantastic tale of imagination.

Charles Darwin married his cousin, Emma Wedgewood. She was wealthy and they lived a comfortable life, Emma died and Charles was left alone, old and a bit crippled. He hired a housekeeper whose name was Hope and some other help to keep his estate going.

Hope had been working for Charles for several years when one day Charles asked her if she was active in the local church. She was, and in fact had led services and Bible studies. He said to her, "I would like you to hold one of your church services in my summer cottage on the grounds, if you will this Sunday at 3 p.m. sing a hymn so you can be sure I will be singing along with you, I will have my window open, for you see Hope, in all my life I have never met anyone who was an example of what the living Christ is as much as you.

Hope told him she had seen the Bible in his room for many months and the marker was always in the book of hebrews. This was the very book he had denied years before. Charles Darwin told her he was a young man then
