



Abner was only fifteen when his parents divorced. Abner would do as he pleased, his step Dad did not care for him and it showed. Abner stopped going to school and he got into a lot of petty trouble. The police got involved and the courts, so Abner went to jail as an adult. He was then about nineteen.

When I first met Abner he was a sullen kid, who was about to be released from jail. He had served over eighteen months. I told him I'd give him a job but no dope or drinking of alcohol. He started to work O.K. About a month later he was missing for three days, when he did show up for his pay he was drunk. I told him I could fire him but I would'nt, instead he would give up booze and drugs completely. If he failed to do this he would be put back in jail.

Abner was cautious in his first few days back. One day he came to me and said, "Nobody ever wanted me, no one ever talked to me the way you do. You are mean to me but I think you care about me". I assured him I did care and if he wanted to continue working with me he would *have* to stop all drinking of alcohol and no drugs, as I had told him before. He told me that he wanted the job and said that he wanted to pattern his life after me.







#### THE OBJECTS OF TALL CEDARISM

- 4. To emphasize that a Master Mason is not only a member of the Blue Lodge to which he belongs, but an integral part of the Masonic fraternity as a whole.
- 5. To teach that a Master Mason should not be judged by his worldly wealth or honors, his social status, or the manner in which he earns his livelihood, but from the viewpoint of true equality.




