You may think it is the poor and disadvantaged that do drugs and use alcohol to excess, but it is not. The rich and well adjusted seem to use alcohol more and toy with drugs.

Tom was like that. When I first saw Tom he was in prison for almost all of his bad crimes. He told me that his father was well to do, his dad was rich and an official in a local gov't. Tom said he and his brother use to bring pot in the home, they were warned not to, but they continued. His dad out of tough love told the two boys if they did not refrain from pot and alcohol they would have to leave. They continued so the dad put them out. They got an apartment and instead of curbing their desire, as they were not under any control, they increased their habit to coke and increased their amount to five times what the street people use. They were under the influence all of the time.

It was at this time of life that the older boy committed suicide. Tom was under a fog so he just stayed on. The police got involved and put Tom away for a long time.

Tom was in prison when I first met him. He was given a good report by the jail Chaplain so I took him out on the idea he was ready to straighten his life out.

Tom had turned his life around it seemed. He would read the bible and tell other young people of his past. He would say how horrible it was. One day I took Tom on a delivery, he had on shoes that looked like rags. I asked if they were all he had, he said they were. So I went to three stores before I could buy a pair to fit him. Tom was a big man, six feet seven and weighed over two hundred pounds. He wore a thirteen size shoe. It was snowing and after a few stops I noticed his hands were red so I took off my gloves and gave them to him. I felt like Father Assisi.

I took Tom to a religious service one day. He wanted to witness for the Lord. I told him I thought he should call his mom. Shortly after this Tom was missing. I thought he had run, but when I found him he was on the phone with his mom.
