I knew BeBe when she was just a young girl. I thought something was very wrong when she would not go with the other girls on various outings. BeBe confided in me her father would not let her and her sisters go, he thought something bad would happen. I told her I would speak with her father and she became quite upset. She told me he was very big and did not want anyone to talk to him. I assured her that I was not afraid and so I did talk with him, after that he said any time you go they can go with you. I told him his rules may not be followed but I would treat the girls the same as my daughter.

Today I saw BeBe in jail. She was put there after many tries of giving up dope. She had been hurt quite severely in an automobile accident. She and her date, the driver, were going over 100 miles per hour when the accident occurred. The driver was killed and BeBe was in the hospital for a long time. She was given pain killers and this is how she said she got hooked on dope. I don't care to beleive or disclaim it, what matters now is she is in jail for a long time.

BeBe is now crying out for help. She needs someone or something to give her new hope. She told me she has given her life to God. She attends church service and is taking correspondance courses. Her case worker and the Chaplain agree she is a new woman.

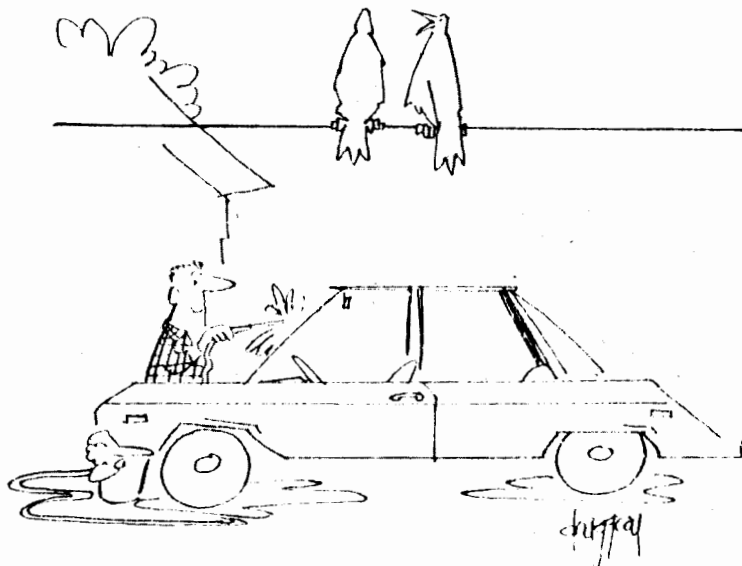
I am going to help BeBe. I have some ideas she may use. Know one wants to be confined to an 8 x 10 foot barred cell for a long time. Each day seems like a year and frustration is ever present.

This is but one life I have seen wasted away in jail. They don't realize at the time of their crime what awaits them when they are caught. They must live a life that God has set for them. They must give their life over to a God.

I will be working with BeBe for a while and as I have told her, she must give up her old buddies and start a new life. The Bible tells us "The old life is gone, the new life begins". I think BeBe will be released from jail soon. The the real person begins. I have seen many a life start at the very bottom and return to a good life.
