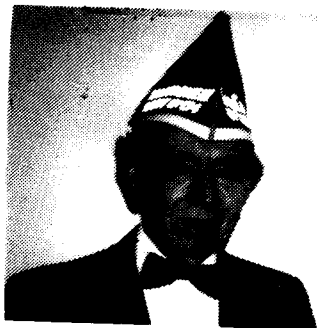

I recall when Bob first called me. He was to be parolled but he needed a job. He asked if I would give him one. I looked into his past and found him to be in jail on a series of crimes, but it all came back to alcohol and drugs. He had been sober and clean for over six years. He was hired and was sober and clean for over six months when I saw he had many legal problems. So on his behalf I went to see Frank, an attorney, who I knew. Frank was quick to tell me he didn't want any alcoholics or drugies or battered women who have no money as clients. He told me his retainer fee was \$500 or more. I told him I would take them elsewhere.

I saw Frank several months later. He had one leg, a crutch and a pants leg pinned up. I asked why he didn't get an artificial leg. He told me as long as he lived he would use his crutch because it always reminded him of how his alcohol addiction took his leg. "If you have anyone in need of an attorney who is an alcoholic, a drug abuser or a battered woman - call me the fee is free, it is the least I can do.

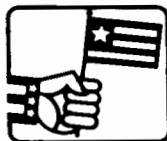

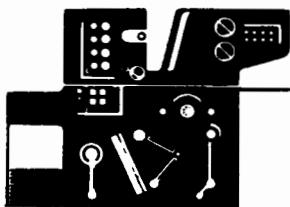
