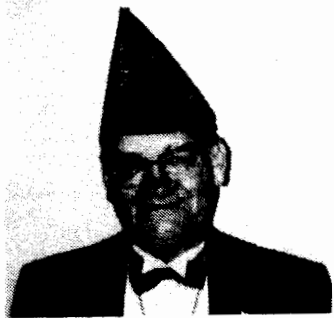

When Doug was released from prison he had a suit and \$25. When I saw Doug on a Sunday morning in front of my office he had only a tee shirt and some wash pants.

Doug said when he was discharged he was given a bus ticket to Baltimore and when he got off the bus he went directly into a pub. It was in the afternoon, he said, and was rolled (first given a drink with a knock out drop in it and left with only the tee shirt and pants).

I got Doug some clothes and sent him to church. He was in jail really because no one cared for him. Doug had a lot of charges and alcohol was behind each one. I insisted he go to A.A. meetings 7 nights a week. Doug worked for me for over three years before he got a job as a bookkeeper. He had been an accountant before.

That was a great lesson for Doug and to this day he is doing fine. He continually gives me credit but all I did was send him the right way without booze and to care for him.

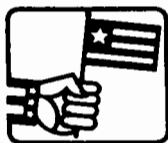

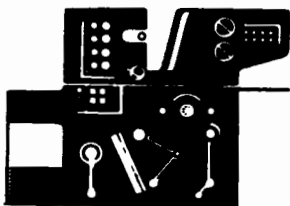
