

I have been to the D.C. Government and the Federal Government many times and asked them to give me people on welfare that were impossible to train. They gave me what seemed to be a ream of paper, to fill out, so I gave up.

Many months later I went back to the D.C. Government and asked again for the most untrained people they had. They laughed when they gave me 24 people. I trained them in hand worked, but I insisted they not use drugs or alcohol at all. All of them had criminal records and jail time. I had many who went to AA and some were in rehab and drug centers. All 24 had to listen to my dissertation on religion. All 24 said they never had anyone show them how to live a better life.

The 24 worked very hard. They all learned their tasks and seemed to like the information about the Bible. The ones the Government said could not be trained, were all placed in full time employment. At last report, the 24 I had trained, were still employed by the same company. That was over a year ago.
