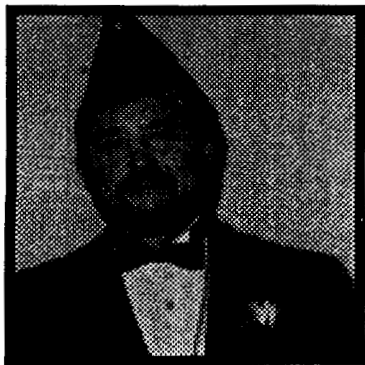


From The Grand Tall Cedar

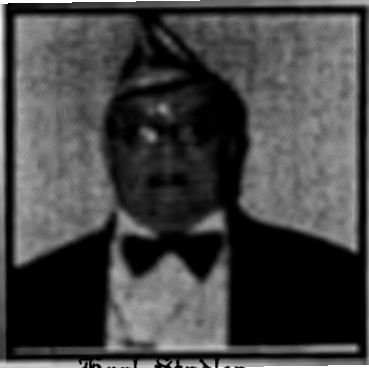
Another **FLASH!** The monthly Executive Board meetings will now be held on the **FIRST MONDAY** at John Huff's home.

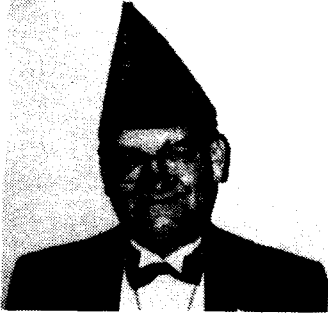

Today Daryl is an ordained minister in Kentucky, the same state his Grandpa was ordained in. Daryl is married and doing just fine. God had his way.

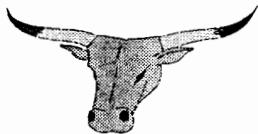
