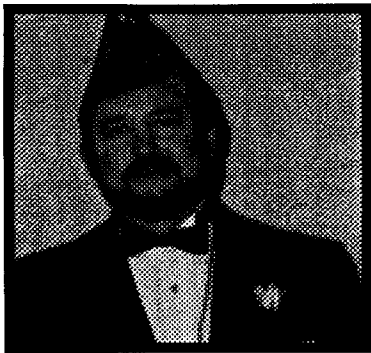

The year is fast rolling by. We have had a great year so far. Let's continue to support your officers and forest, as well as the visits to other forest to get their support for us.

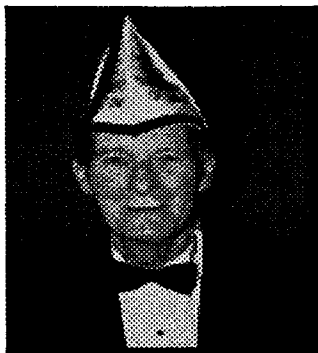
We need to get some new members in the forest. We are losing members, but not getting new ones. In May it will be Past Officers Night and a dinner before hand.

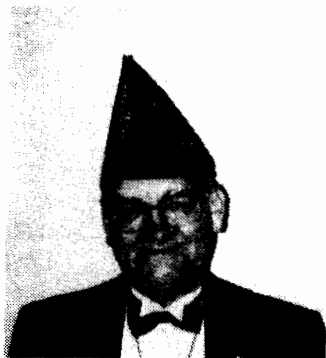

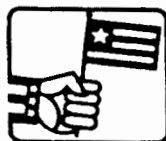
