





#### HISTORY OF MONTGOMERY FOREST NO. 134

The thought of a Forest in Montgomery County, Maryland was in the minds of two members of Capitol Forest No. 104, TCL of Washington, D.C., and who resided in Silver Spring, Maryland. They were George T. Heilman and Layton H. Miner, members of the Color Guard of Capitol Forest. On seeing the population growth in suburban Washington, the possibility of a Forest in that Community seemed advantageous.

This was taken up with William D. Senger, PGTC of Baltimore Forest No. 45 and at that time was a member of the Extension Committee of the Supreme Forest. This interview took place at a meeting of Annapolis Forest No. 126, Annapolis, Maryland. A meeting of interested persons was called and held at the Home of William H. Enyeart, 612 Forest Glen Road, Silver Spring, Maryland on September 17, 1947 at the suggestion and authority of William D. Senger. Among those attending this meeting were William H. Enyeart, Donald A. Smith, Everett B. Terry, George T. Heilman, Robert T. Gerstmyer, Frank Marshall, Theodore A. Mohler and Layton H. Miner.

Temporary Officers for the new Forest were elected to serve for 1947; William H. Enyeart, Grand Tall Cedar; Donald A. Smith, Scribe; and Everett B. Terry, Treasurer. The name of Maryland Forest was first selected but changed later to Montgomery Forest, because it was formulated in the largest community of Montgomery County. Business transacted was that of establishing initiation fees, dues, policies, practices, etc.

This was followed by a second organization meeting held on October 4, 1947 at the Silver Spring #215 Masonic Temple, Wayne and Georgia Aves., Silver Spring, Md., at 8:05 p.m., attended by between 45 and 50 Master Masons – potential members. William D. Senger, PGTC Baltimore Forest No. 45 and a member of the Supreme Forest Extension Committee, C. Morris DeLauder, District Representative of District #14, John McFaul, PGTC of Baltimore Forest and a member of the Publicity Committee of the Supreme Forest, and John R. Jenkins, PGTC of Capitol Forest No. 104, gave talks on the requirements necessary to start a Forest.

This was followed by a meeting on November 15, 1947 at the home of William R. Enyeart. The institution date was set for January 24, 1948 with Capitol Forest No. 104 as the Mother Forest. Thomas D. Havell, PGTC of Capitol Forest and PSTC of 1939 was present and assured them of his support. This was followed by a final organizational meeting at the Enyeart Home on December 21, 1947 where details of the parade and the institution of the Forest was arranged.

Montgomery Forest No. 134, TCL was instituted at the National Guard Armory, Silver Spring, Maryland on Saturday, January 24, 1948. It can be noted that the parade was held although nine inches with a blizzard visited Silver Spring at that time.

Supreme Tall Cedar Frank E. Jenks called the meeting to order for the purpose of instituting the Forest to be known as Montgomery Forest No. 134, and the Supreme Scribe, Edmund H. Reeves read the application. One hundred and fifty-three petitions for membership were submitted by Donald A. Smith, Scribe. The Officers to serve for the year 1948 were announced as follows: William R. Enyeart, Grand Tall Cedar; Leonard G. Daymude, Senior Deputy Grand Tall Cedar; Layton H. Miner, Junior Deputy Grand Tall Cedar; Donald A. Smith, Scribe; Everett B. Terry, Treasurer; Miller, Orville J. Montgomery, and Thurston, Trustees. The Officers were installed by the District Representative, C. Morris DeLauder of District #14.

At this meeting, 111 members were obligated and the Prolog and Royal Court were exemplified by Capitol Forest No. 104, as well as the Sidonian Degree.
