

Forest will have a full-fledged team this year. Please come out and join us! I look forward to seeing you all there!


Finally, if you are planning on attending the spring convention, please let our Scribe/Treasurer Romain Tweedy know as soon as possible! *Tom*



Matthew Haley 1975 - 2019

Matthew Gabriel Haley was born on February 19, 1975. Matthew was diagnosed with Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) on March 1977 at John Hopkins. A Big Thank You to GTC Bob Thomson who introduced us to Matthew and his parents at the Tall Cedar convention in 1982. The Montgomery Cedarettes decided to adopt him as our Muscular Dystrophy child (that is what it was called then).

We invited Matthew and his parents to all of our dinners and installations. We paid for him and his parents to join us at convention every year while his health allowed. When Matthew graduated high school, all of the Cedarettes and their husbands were invited to their home for a picnic. We all brought a dish to share. For his graduation gift, we gave him what he had asked for... a flag pole for the front of his home where he lived with his parents. Mathew went on to college where he graduated from UMBC in 2000 with a Computer Arts Degree. He realized that he physically could not sit in an office and work for 8 hours a day, 40 hours per week. Therefore, he took college classes on-line in accounting, thinking he could work from home. Unfortunately, his health worsened and most of the day was spent in bed, instead of his wheelchair.

Matthew did not get to earn a living as he planned. If he did not have SMA, he wanted to be a fighter pilot and serve his country. Fortunately, Mathew was lucky in love and married his soul mate Tolu in 2006. They had a house built and moved to New Market Virginia in 2008.

Unfortunately, due to his health, he could not come to any more meetings, installations, or dinners that were held at Montgomery Forest; therefore, most of you did not get to know him, his Mother Alice, or his wife Tolu. Lucky for us, I was able to talk to him every month to give my Muscular Dystrophy report and Marshall and I were able to see him several times and continue our friendship. We were lucky to have known Matthew Haley.
