Whitsunday (What is it?)

Whitsunday is the 50th day after Easter or the 7th Sunday after Easter. Also known as Pentecost, it commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit on the disciples. It marks the beginning of the Christian church's mission to the world. In the early church, Christians referred to the entire 50-day period following Easter as Pentecost. Baptism was administered both at the beginning (Easter) and end (the day of Pentecost) of the season. Eventually, Pentecost became a more popular time for baptism than Easter in northern Europe, and in England the feast was commonly called White Sunday (Whitsunday) for the special white garments worn by the newly baptized.
