~DID YOU KNOW?~

Penryn isn't just the home of our beloved lodge, it is also a city in <u>Cornwall, England</u>. <u>Penryn</u> has a rich history dating back to premedieval times.



- Penryn translates to "promontory" in Cornish. The city itself is located on a spot of high ground between two creeks. It is about a mile north of Falmouth in modern day Cornwall at the South-Western tip of England. The town dates back to 1236, when it was first enfranchised by the <u>Bishop of</u> <u>Exeter</u>.
- Penryn was an important harbor in the middle ages, and it was known particularly for its export of *granite*. This Cornish Penryn granite was used in constructions worldwide throughout the centuries; most notably in the London Bridge.
- Griffith Griffith, the builder of our lodge, was from Wales, also in South-Western England where he worked at a Welsh stone quarry. Griffith wanted to

- name his new granite quarry in California after the <u>Penrhyn Slate</u> <u>Quarry</u> where he had worked, but later dropped the "h" to avoid confusion with the locals.
- Cornwall's town of Penryn has its own Masonic Hall, which is home to no less than 5 separate Masonic Lodges chartered under the <u>Provincial Grand</u> <u>Lodge of Cornwall</u>, which operates under the <u>United Grand Lodge of</u> <u>England</u>. The Lodges are:
 - o Three Grand Principles
 - o Pendennis
 - o St. Gluvias
 - o St. Budoc's
 - o Cornish Maritime
