Unfortunately, we also have to discuss the different options of raising the dues for our Chapter. GRAND CHAPTER has raised the Per Capita an additional \$4.50 per member

Penrhyn's Dues = \$20.00 + \$5.00 Home Assessment (for those who have not purchased a life sponsorship.

Breakdown of where the Money goes:

\$8.50 = Grand Chapter annual dues assessment; \$5.75 = Grand Chapter insurance assessment; \$2.00 = Grand Chapter Home Maintenance fund; \$.45 = Grand Chapter Benevolent Fund; \$.25 = Grand Chapter Session assessment; \$.10 = Grand Chapter Scholarship assessment; \$1.00 = General Grand Chapter assessment; \$18.05 = Total to Grand Chapter; \$1.95 = Money to Penrhyn Chapter. Subtracting another 88 cents for mailing dues notices and dues receipts brings the Chapter's share down to \$1.07. Also to be considered is that it was approved at Grand Chapter to increase the per capita tax by 50 cents in each of the next 3 years automatically.

Options: 1) Raise dues to a flat fee of \$40-\$50 per member

- 2) Keeps dues at \$20 + per capita (for example, \$20.00 dues plus \$18.05 per capita tax for a total of \$38.05)
- 3) Raise dues + per capita
