The October 2012 Southern California Research Lodge Fraternal Review has an article about Masonic etiquette and protocol. Here are this month's installments:

- 1. One of the peculiarities of the Masonic Fraternity is that a man attends a Lodge meeting or Lodge gathering not as a private individual, but as a Mason. He is therefore to be addressed by his surname, i.e., "Brother Smith" rather than "Brother Bill."
- 2. The Grand Master is never to be addressed at any Masonic gathering by his first name, no matter how close an individual may feel toward him. His proper address is "Most Worshipful" and when being formally received in a Lodge, he is accorded his full title, "Most Worshipful (full name), Grand Master of Masons in XX."
- 3. The Worshipful Master must be shown the same respect and courtesy we show the Grand Master. He should be addressed at all times as "Worshipful."
