The lambskin apron is the distinguishing badge of a Mason. First in it's use, it is a badge of service, secondly, made of lambskin in it's fabric a badge of sacrifice. He who wears this apron with understanding must be prepared for the time when hard things are to be done. When trials are to be endured, and fortitude glorified. In its color it is a badge of purity. White is the clean color that reflects the most light. As a badge of antiquity, it emphasizes the values of the past. Present progress must be based on the accumulated experience and the wisdom of the ages. Finally, the apron is a badge of HONOR! As a badge of HONOR, the lambskin apron spells out INTEGRITY, HONESTY, CHARACTER and MORAL PRINCIPAL. If the mission of FREEMASONRY is to make good men better, then let the APRON serve as a reminder of just exactly what it is that makes GOOD MEN BETTER.
