

## THE D. WALTER JESSEN, SR. SCHOLARSHIP FOR A JUNIOR OR SENIOR CIVIL ENGINEERING STUDENT

The Scholarships were established by the five Scottish Rite Bodies of Louisiana in honor of D. W. Jessen, Sr., Past Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Louisiana, Free and Accepted Masons, and Sovereign Grand Inspector General of Scottish Rite Masons in the Orient of Louisiana, at his mandatory retirement at the age of eighty (80) years.

The Scholarships, a grant of \$2,000.00 each, will be awarded annually to <u>rising</u> Junior or Senior students enrolled in an accredited Civil Engineering curriculum at a Louisiana college or university. Each grant will be awarded to a student who is in the upper half of his/her class, has demonstrated leadership capabilities through involvement in engineering college and campus activities, and shows potential for development into a motivated, innovative, well-rounded and successful practicing professional engineer. Financial need will be a significant determining factor. The student will submit a 300-500 word essay explaining how his/her leadership role in college will help in attaining his/her goals and objectives as a practicing engineer.

	I understand that if my application is granted, earnest and studious work will be required, and I must maintain a full-time status (12 or more semester hours or 9 or more quarter hours per term).
	Further, I must maintain a 3.0 or better grade point average on a 4.0 scale, with no grade lower than a "C".
	I also agree to have my official transcripts promptly mailed at the close of each semester/quarter to the address above.
	I understand that, if my grant is approved, the grant will be sent to the college or university which I attend, and if I fail to attend, I will promptly notify the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee of the Louisiana Scottish Rite Foundation. On the semester system, 1/2 of the grant (\$1,000) will be sent at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters. On the quarter system, 1/3 of the grant (\$667.00) will be sent at the beginning of each quarter.
	I further understand that this financial assistance is subject to the conditions that I have agreed to, and that if I should not keep this agreement, my scholarship will be terminated.
	This scholarship is designed to assist junior or senior level Civil Engineering students. However, the grant for a junior may be renewed for the senior year, provided the student maintains the qualifications and requests such renewal in writing.
