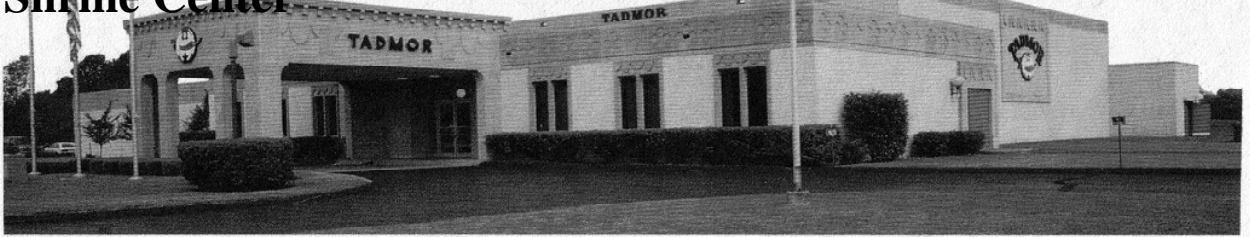

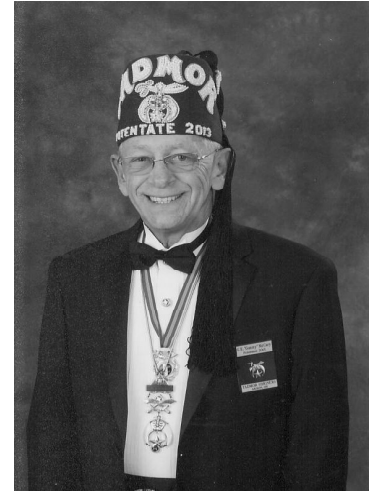

### ILLUSTRIOUS SIR GARLAND “GUNNY” MCCARY

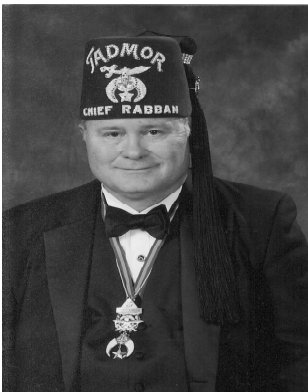

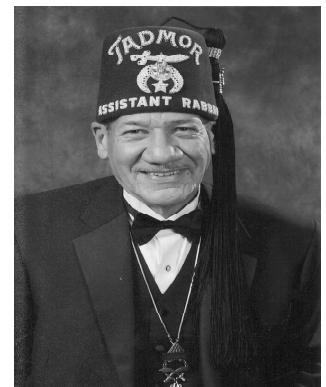

## ORIENTAL GUIDE DILLON HICKMAN

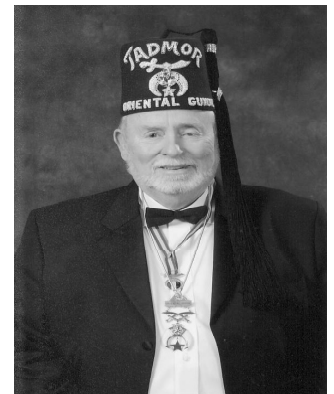
Dillon and his Lady Beth have been married for 35 years and reside in Uniontown. They have six grown children and sixteen grandchildren.

Dillon is a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, having served four years and attaining the rank of Staff Sergeant E5.

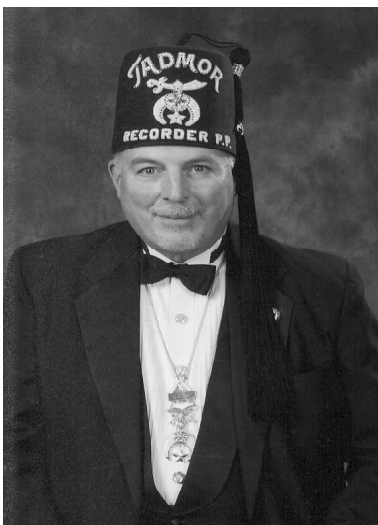

Gary is a second generation potentate here at Tadmor, following his father's lead, Ill. Sir Corum "CC" DeMoss who served as Potentate in 1972.

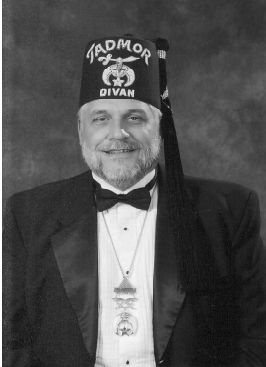
Gary was appointed to the Divan in 1996 by then Ill. Sir Crinley Hoover as the Second Ceremonial Officer and then became Potentate in 2002.

### Grand Lodge of Ohio:

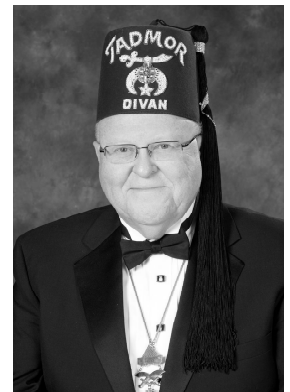

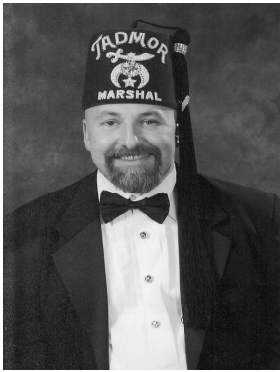
R.W. Williams joined Tadmor Shriners in 1994 and was appointed 2<sup>nd</sup> Ceremonial for 2013.

## **INNER GUARD TODD BARDELLI**

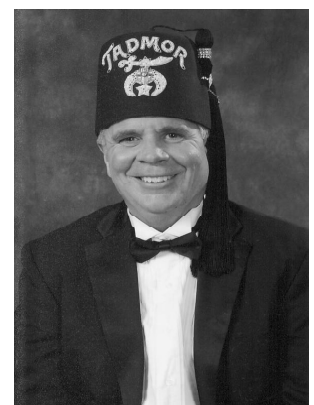

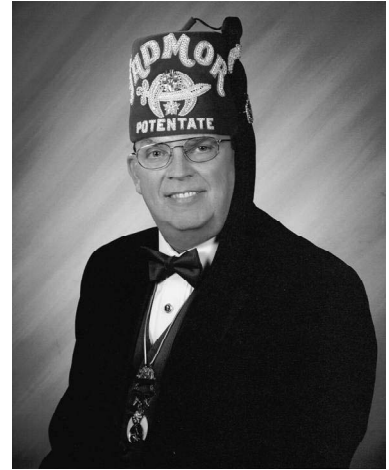

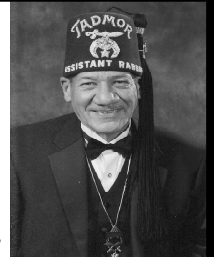
As I write my article for the April Shrinews, the circus has not taken place yet. I can only assume that it went well as it usually does.

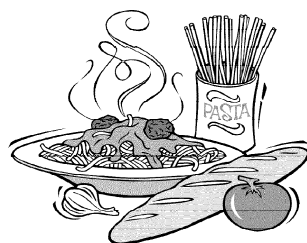
