
OFFICIAL NOTICE OF ANNUAL ELECTION

Election of Officers of Tadmor Shrine Center of the Shriners International will be held at the stated meeting on Friday, December 14, 2012 at 7:00 EST at Tadmor Shrine 3000 Krebs Drive, Akron, Ohio 44319. Section 325.10 Election Regulations: (a) The printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets or other devices by a Noble, suggesting, recommending, opposing or containing the names of proposed candidates for the office in the Temple is prohibited. (b) For any violation of (a) the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble and he may declare the election of the Officers void and order a new election. (c) at least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the Temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section. ERIE HOSPITAL FOR CHILDREN REPORT

At the November Erie Board Meeting there were 267 new patient applications received. This is a record for the year.


It was brought to the board's attention that they should inform their Shrine Center's members that it is important that any donation made to a Shriners Hospital be sent directly to the hospital and not Tampa, FL. Any donation sent to Tampa in the name of a hospital is not recorded to that hospital. This allows the hospital to be measured by the percentage of their expenses that are offset by donations received.

Through October, 121 inpatient surgical cases were completed at SHC- Philadelphia, Children's Hospital Pittsburgh and UPMC Hamot.

As you may have heard from previous communications from Shriners Hospital for Children and Shriners International, it is no longer necessary for families to complete an "application" in order to be considered for treatment at Shriners Hospitals for Children facilities. A new process has been put in place that eliminates the need to fill out the complex two-page form that previously needed to be sent to the hospital and processed before a patient can be considered for treatment. In Erie Hospital's case, just call Bridget Hines, Admissions/Applications at 814-875-8866

NOBLE, CAN YOU SPAREADIME?

Most of you will not remember, but may have read about it. This is a parody to the phrase "Brother Can You Spare A Dime" created in the days of the great depression. Now, if this heading has stirred your curiosity, that is indeed the intent to do so. Please read on:

Our Shrine Temple is facing some of the same problems that face many organizations. We have increasing costs coupled with declining membership. Without our numerous volunteers, who do the actual work of repairing, rebuilding, general up keep, our problems would be much greater. It is impossible to name names, and I know I would certainly miss a couple, but I am proud of these Nobles who give so much to our Shrine. Even with our volunteer labor, we must buy materials for the various projects. Some say, "Just increase the dues" but I don't see that as the solution to those pressing issues. Increased costs are everywhere; garbage, water, electricity, heat, air conditioning, etc. Many ask, "What are they, doing with the money"? Yet, if a worthy cause is mentioned, we are at the ready to open our wallets and support the endeavor. So here are my thoughts on what we as Shriners are constituted for and how we could solve some of our financial problems.

The Shrine Temple is the place from which all blessings flow and we must keep a financially sound Temple. We exist to support Shriners Hospitals for Children. Without the Temples, we would lose the money raised by our Clubs and Units. It has been said that charity begins at home, and personally, I feel that this is a worthy charity and we need to open our wallets wide. We have 1,931 members in the Nile and if each of us gave a dime a day, we would raise about \$70,000 a year. I realize we would not get a 100% participation, but we can always hope. The acronym for Dime A Day is "DAD" Fund, which we, symbolically are for the children in our hospitals. DAD Fund donations are only dispersed with the consent of the Nobility.

Something has to be done to increase our income. If this sounds like a good idea to you, send in your check to the DAD Fund (Dime-a-Day-Fund)today. Don't wait until tomorrow, do it now. If any of you ladies are reading this, get out the old sugar bowl, put a dime a day in it and give it to your Noble each year. A dime a day is quite painless, but it would contribute to the financial stability of your Temple So in closing, I will say "Noble, Can You Spare A Dime"?




CANTON-MASSILLON SHRINE CLUB By Donald L. Corbett, Secretary

Proceeds From This Circus Benefit Tadmor Shrine Center. They Do Not Directly Benefit The Shriners' Hospitals For Children.

I've written to you about the values that I have tried to govern my life by, the Boy Scout Oath, Law and Motto, the Army's Creed of the Non-Commissioned Officer and the Shriners Creed. I wrote that at every important event of my life that whenever I have stood on these tenets, I have experienced their value in the positive outcomes of events; as I have experienced the negative outcomes when I have strayed from them. I have also written that I believe participation of the Nobility has reached a critical point in the history of Tadmor Temple and that the future of our Temple is going to require serious leadership and the participation of the Nobility. I challenged the Nobility to "step-up" and get involved and elect the best people you can for our leadership team because we can no longer afford to make mistakes and live through them in the hope that things will get better next year. I have also written that if we are going to be Shriners and live by our creed, there is a need for the forgiving spirit of our creed - that no one is perfect, people make mistakes and that if we are to truly be brothers, we must have forgiveness in us; that this is not a business where only results count, that it is a fraternity of men who have chosen to be brothers. My brothers, I have strayed from these values recently.

I was approached by some of you to run for Potentate in the upcoming election and I responded that I would serve if elected. At the time, I was caught up in the emotion of the moment. There have been a number of things occur over the last three or four months that have convinced some that a significant change is needed, that there are members of the elected Divan that should not be part of the leadership of our Temple. There are those that believe they have contributed more and deserve better leadership. They are passionate in their beliefs. I permitted myself to be caught up in this passion for a time. This was wrong of me and I can no longer run for that office. It goes against the values I have previously spoken of. I will no longer participate in the perpetuation of the ill feelings some have for brother Nobles. We are a Fraternity of men that all took oaths to support one another.

In my experience members of the elected Divan have contributed a significant part of their lives to our Temple. They have chosen to be there when others have not. They have provided, in some cases, the financial equity and the sweat equity of events for a number of years at our Temple. They have taken on the responsibility of trying to come up with realistic solutions to the growing issues our Temple faces at the most critical time in the history of this Shrine. They have done so in spite of the decline in membership which has lead to a decline in financial resources. It has never been more difficult to be a member of the elected Divan. I will not make it more difficult for my brothers that have made the decision to be on the elected Divan.

I realize that some of you will believe that I have let you down. For this, I take full responsibility for my actions. It was my mistake as a Mason and a Shriner. I publicly say to all that I am sorry and ask your forgiveness.

It is my most sincere wish that we can all put the events that have lead us to our present state of affairs behind us and move forward as brothers, Masons and Shriners.
