Executive Secretary Transition Period

The Treasurer will oversee the Executive Committee Meetings and coordinate day-to-day operations, with the assistance of the Trustees.



Sausage Balls

3 cups Bisquick
2 cups grated Cheddar Cheese
1 pound fresh ground sausage (hot or mild)

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Mix all ingredients together.

If not moist enough, add a little water. Form mixture into 1 inch balls. Bake for 15 minutes. Drain on paper towels.

Serve warm (This freezes well before or after baking.)
