March 30

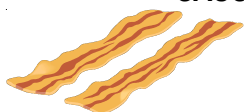

Old Fashioned Bread Pudding

Heat to scalding: 2 cups milk, pour over 4 cups coarse bread crumbs.
Cool and add: 1/4 cup melted butter, 1/2 cup sugar, 2 eggs, slightly beaten, 1/4 teaspoon salt, 1/2 cup seeded raisins and 1 teaspoon of cinnamon or nutmeg.
Pour into buttered 1 1/2 qt. casserole. Set in pan of hot water (1" deep).
Bake until a silver knife inserted in pudding comes out clean. Serve warm.
