RESOLUTION TO INCREASE DUES INTRODUCED

TO BE READ AT THE SEPTEMBER STATED MEETING BELOW IS A REPRINT OF THE RESOLUTION WHICH WILL BE READ ON THE FLOOR OF THE LODGE DURING THE STATED MEETING SEPT. 13. BALLOTING ON THE RESOLUTION WILL BE HELD AT THE STATED MEETING ON OCT. 11TH. EVERYONE SHOULD GIVE VERY CAREFUL CONSIDERATION TO THE VARIOUS FACTORS WHICH HAVE MADE THIS MOVE NECESSARY.

RESOLUTION TO AMEND BY LAWS

A DECREASE IN PETITIONS; A LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP; INSURANCE LIABILITY CRISIS, PLUS THE INFLATIONARY TREND WHICH AFFECT ORGANIZATIONS AS WELL AS INDIVIDUALS; HAS CAUSED US TO RE-EVALUATE OUR POSITION AND TO TAKE STEPS TO HALT OUR RISING DEFICIT. WE HAVE HAD A STEADY DECLINE IN INCOME FROM DUES AND NEW MEMBERSHIP. IF WE CONTINUE TO OFFER AND MAINTAIN OUR PRESENT PROGRAMS, WE WILL FACE OVER 30,000.00 DEFICIT NEXT YEAR AND THE FOLLOWING YEARS. OUR LAST DUES INCREASE WAS 2004. YOUR EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE DOES NOT WANT TO LOWER STANDARDS OF OPERATION WHICH WILL HAVE AN ADVERSE AFFECT ON THE ATTITUDE OF THE MEMBERS; AND ESPECIALLY THE WORKERS IN OUR VALLEY.

THEREFORE, TO ALLEVIATE A SITUATION WHICH THREATENS TO GROW WORSE, BE IT RESOLVED TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL DUES BY FIFTEEN DOLLARS AND CONTINUE TO COLLECT TEN DOLLARS AND 50 CENTS SUPREME COUNCIL ASSESSMENT, TO BE EFFECTIVE WITH DUES PAYABLE JANUARY 1, 2007.

FURTHER: THAT ARTICLE IX, SECTION 1, OF THE BY-LAWS WILL BE AMENDED TO READ “THE DUES OF THE SCOTTISH RITE, VALLEY OF TERRE HAUTE, SHALL BE 69.50 PER ANNUM, FOR EACH MEMBER OF ANY OR ALL OF THE FOUR CONSTITUENT BODIES, PAYABLE ANNUALLY IN ADVANCE OF OR BEFORE JANUARY 1ST OF EACH YEAR; AND IN ADDITION, EACH MEMBER SHALL PAY THE SUPREME COUNCIL ASSESSMENT OF TEN DOLLARS AND 50 CENTS. DUES PAYMENTS CANNOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT OF THE ASSESSMENT.”
