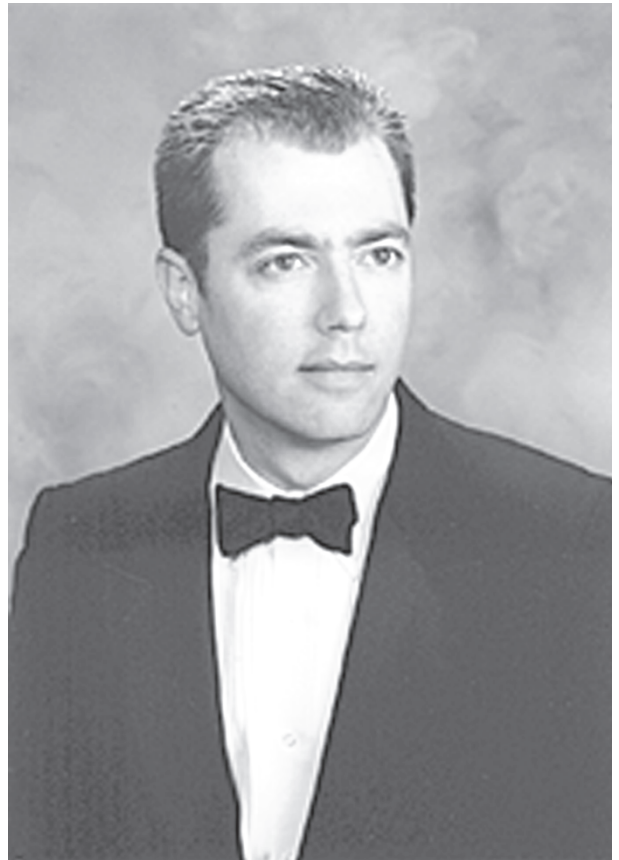
### NEW YEARS RESOLUTIONS

### Did you know?

#### Cyril Cox, Gentleman and Mason

Cyril Cox was the first organist for the Valley of Terre Haute.

Cyril was a charter member of the Valley of Terre Haute and paid for the organ as a donation to the Valley. That organ is still in use to the present day. The top of the line in 1950 was Hammond. The advantage to the Hammond was in longevity of service and low maintenance and our Hammond was hailed by the technicians of the Paramount Music Palace as "the best Hammond organ in existence." Cyril made a trip to the Wilking Music Company in Indianapolis where purchased the instrument and had it delivered to the Valley of Terre Haute and never asked for reimbursement. When the instrument was installed he said, "Now we have an organ." This dedicated member is a shining example of our fraternity and an example of what makes the Valley of Terre Haute great.
