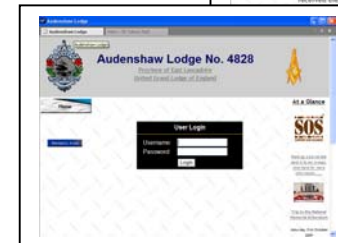
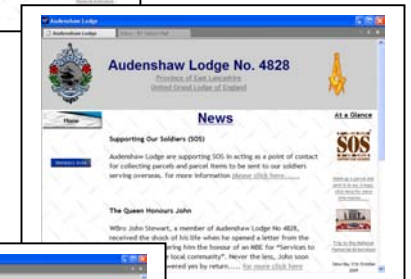
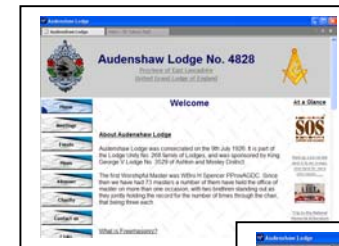
Bro Marsh at his installation on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2009, presented a website to the lodge as a gift.
