A keystone of our work is to raise funds in support of the Masonic Home for children.

The Home is a residential child care facility that provides basic care to children in need - children whose care cannot be provided in their own home or for whom group care is a positive alternative.

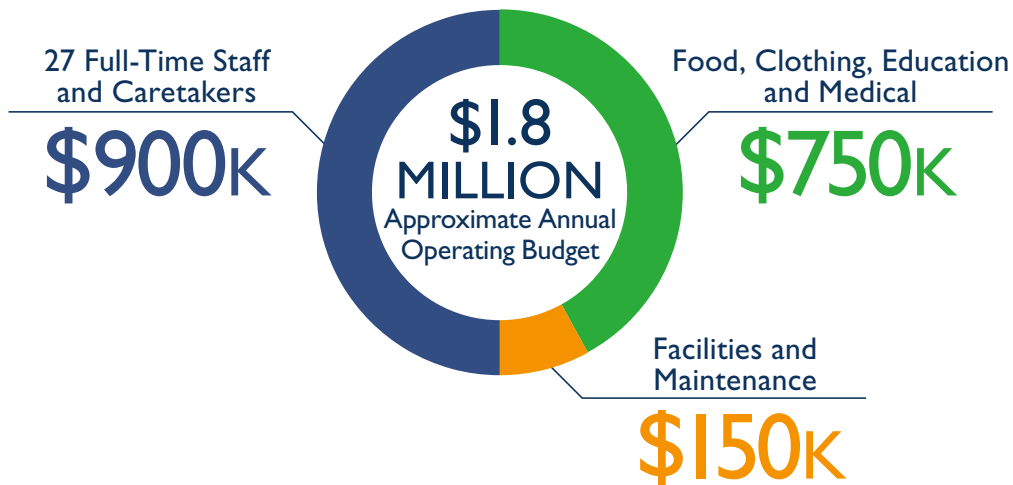
The Home is a non profit organization that receives no funding from State or Federal Governments. The annual budget is derived from interest income from our Endowment Fund, private donations, a per-capita tax (assessed to all Georgia Masons).

Why We Need Your Help Today

In Georgia, nearly 1.2 million children live in low-income households. About 118,000 of those live in a home with no parent present.*
