**THE PHILOSOPHICAL CORNER**

Okay , I have had enough. The triangle with the eye on the back of a one dollar bill is not, never has been and never will be a purely Masonic symbol. I would be so bold as to tell people that there are no symbols, doodles, or markings that can state for a fact that they are only applicable to this idea or this religion or this group of people. There is only so many ways that one can manipulate the horizontal and vertical planes. Please media outlets, special report producers, and every one at the history channel , take this statement to be a truism and just let is lie.
