The inaugural meeting of the Association was held in the Council Chamber of the Ilford Town Hall on 27th September 1918. At that meeting W/Bro. Ben Henderson was elected the Association's first Chairman and Bro. Sir Peter Griggs as it's first Patron.

Within 6 months the Association was able to boast over 100 members including Sir John Bethell MP, Lord Lambourne and Sir Francis Lloyd who were also elected as Patrons.

Today the Association still has an extensive membership and continues to offer lecture meetings which are presented by knowledgeable, entertaining and distinguished brethren.

The aims & objectives of the Association are:-

- ◆ to encourage members of the Craft to meet for the purpose of learning and fostering interest.
- ◆ to hold lecture meetings on regular evenings during the year on both Masonic and non-Masonic subjects of interest.
- ◆ to support Masonic and non-Masonic Institutions and other local charities by donation.

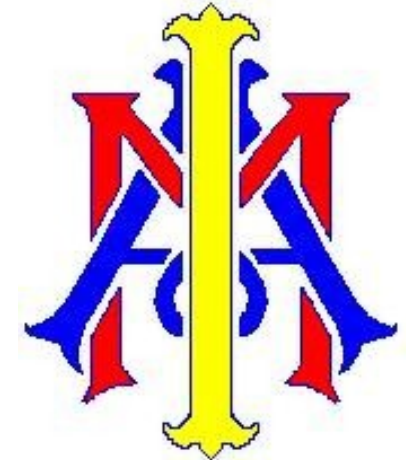

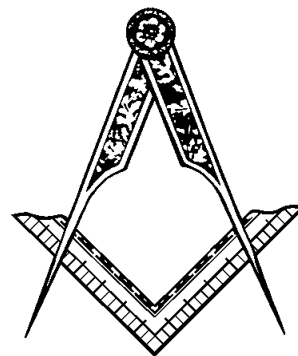
