Part two on emblems of Masonry: The Compasses
The compasses are a device consisting of a pair
of legs of equal length, fixed together at their
apex by an adjustable hinge. It is used for drawing circles and circular arcs, and for taking or
marking off distances along a line.

To Masons, the compasses symbolize our intention to draw a boundary line around our own desires and passions, and our determination to keep ourselves within that circle of self-restraint and moderation, which is the foundation of morality and wisdom.

Since classical times, compasses and the straight-edge (a plain unmarked ruler) have been the basic tools of geometry, used in proofs and construction. Compasses symbolize the science of Geometry, which is the basis of architecture, and more generally is the symbol of mankind's ability to learn about the world around us.
