

LETTER TO GRAND LODGE re; Jackson 17 Moving to Michigan Center

Included with this months mailing, is a copy of the letter sent to Grand Lodge in reference to Jackson 17's impending move to Michigan Center. The content of the letter is not simply how one person felt . . . but rather how the entire line of officers (plus Brothers attending) felt.

Jackson Lodge No 17 assumed that their move would be approved by Grand Lodge and acted accordingly.
