

Jackson Lodge 17 Moving to Michigan Center?

That's right . . . that is their intent! In 1845 there was but one Lodge in Jackson . . . and that was St. John's Lodge No 3. As reported by the Masonic News (Centennial Edition) printed by the Grand Lodge of Michigan F. & A. M. in 1926 . . . "Serious discord having crept into the membership" the Lodge surrendered its charter in 1847.

Shortly thereafter, two factions applied to the Grand Lodge for a charter. One became Jackson Lodge No 17, and the other Michigan Lodge No 50.

For 156 years, Jackson Lodge No 17 & Michigan Lodge No 50 have shared a Temple in Jackson. They agreed to share a Temple in 1853, and have shared one ever since. But now, Jackson No 17 wishes to move.

If they do . . . they will be the only ones with a vote on their new Temple Board. Renters should be aware. We are not moving!
