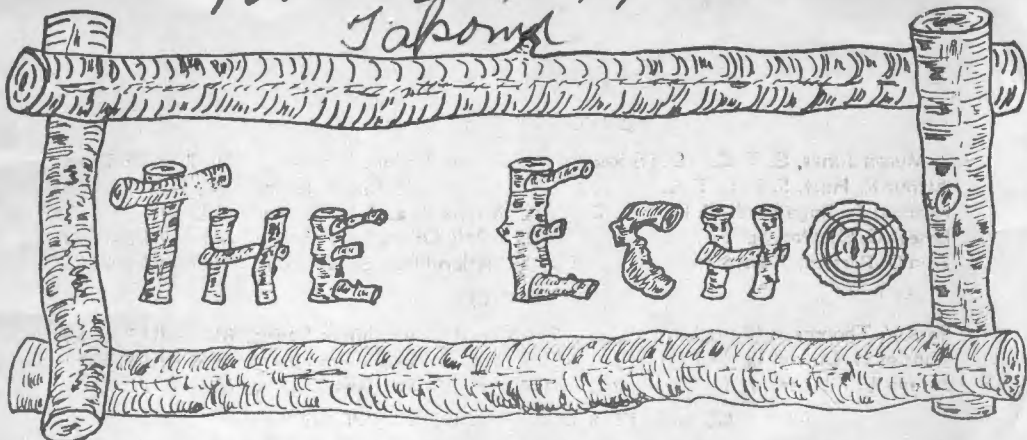

# NEW YEAR'S EVE PARTY

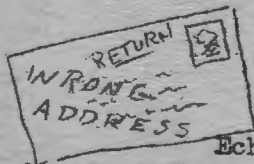

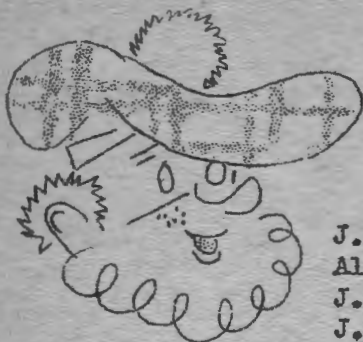
## ADDRESS CHANGES
