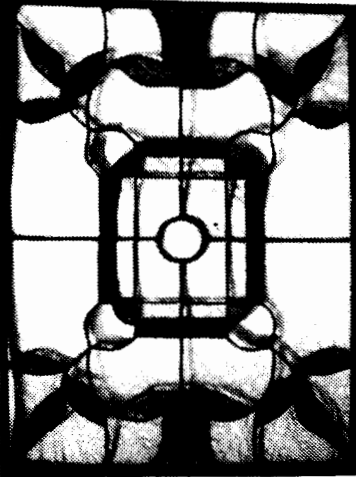



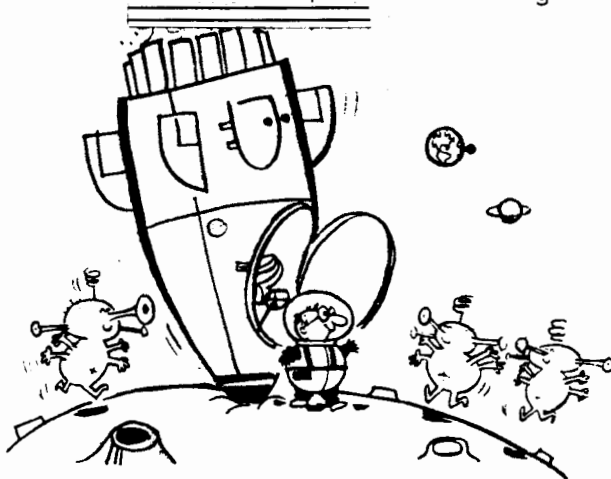

seven churches. He started a rehab center for alcoholics. His daughter had married and he had a grandson.

At this time in our talk he broke down. This strong leader of men was so moved by the mention of his grandson that he cried. When he gained composure he told me how the grandson's father was quite rigid and the boy rebelled. The boy had been a runaway several times, always coming to the grandfather's house. The parents made him come home and put punishment on him each time.

Recently the boy was charged by the police with larceny. The judge and parents agreed the boy would go live with his grandparents. This was to last as long as his probation. His case was turned over to the grandfather's jurisdiction.

Early on the same day the Rev. D. and I had our visit, the grandson was once more charged for larceny; this time in the grandfather's area. No wonder this man was upset. He told me "I don't know what to do." He had obtained a lawyer.

He wanted me to talk to the boy. I told him that wouldn't do much good. I had a better plan. I talked with the boy and we agreed to talk to the lawyer and see if I could appear before the judge and ask that the grandson be put on extended probation with the understanding he would work for me; and with his consent I would report to the court if he broke his probation in any way. He agreed with a great relief.

I made it clear to the boy that I wanted to help and there were others in the plant who also wanted to help. We wanted to be his friends. I told of how others in the plant had been in jail and through the power of God had made a complete recovery.

This young man worked for me for about six months and he continued to live with his grandparents. His parents visited on many weekends.

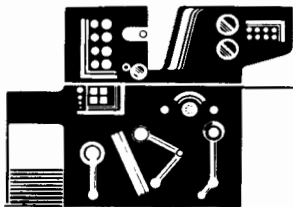

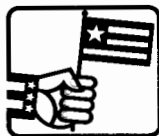
