Our units will be prepared for the convention on May 30 to June 2. We are staying at the same place Ala Moana, that we stayed the last time we visited Wild wood


The May meeting will be Master Mason Night and open, so invite your mason friends to be a part of this meeting. It is not too early to ask them.




