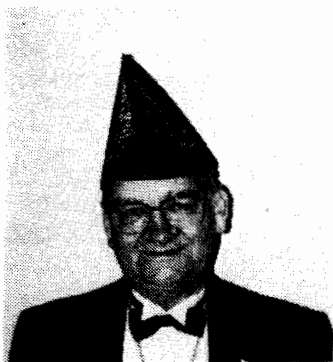

Then I will say to them, "I never knew you . Away from me you evil doers."

When I first heard of Tyrone Jr. he had been in jail several years. His father Tyrone Sr. was also in the same jail for many years. I really came because Tyrone III had been asking for someone to talk to. I think the rest of the family had given up on them. They had no visitors as far as I could tell.

Although I had come to see Tyrone III I decided to see the Granddad. He said he was not really trying to help himself and then his son was incarcerated. He said he felt bad that he had not been a better father, but now his grandson was committed, he said he would do anything to help the boy. So we had many meetings. I had not yet seen the other two. In one talk the Granddad said you know I pray for that boy. I asked if he attended the chapel and had he given the rest of his life to Jesus. He told me no, he just prays. "I'm not very religious. I feel funny in church, my brothers in jail would think I'm soft. I assured him the only way to help his Grandson was to "serve" his God with all his heart and in all his ways. "Why you could be the jailhouse lay preacher, try it, you'll be amazed at how good you feel" He did take my advice, but he was in many fights because of his preaching. In one fight he lost the sight in one eye. He told me that was the turning point. The best thing that could have happened, he said "My life is now totally devoted to Jesus. I serve him everyday the best I can. I also talk to my son and Grandson, maybe they will come to Him one day.

The last I saw Tyrone was some years ago. I recently found out that the Grandfather was still in jail. The son and Grandson have been released. The Grandson is now an ordained Minister and his father is one of the elders in the same church. This is not just a happy ending but a miracle.
