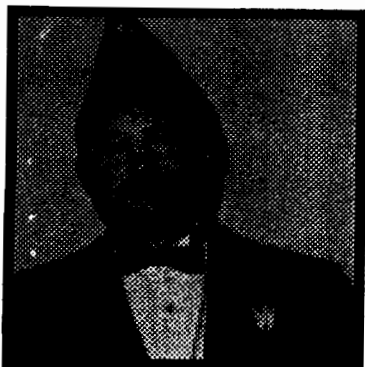


### BROTHER CEDARS.

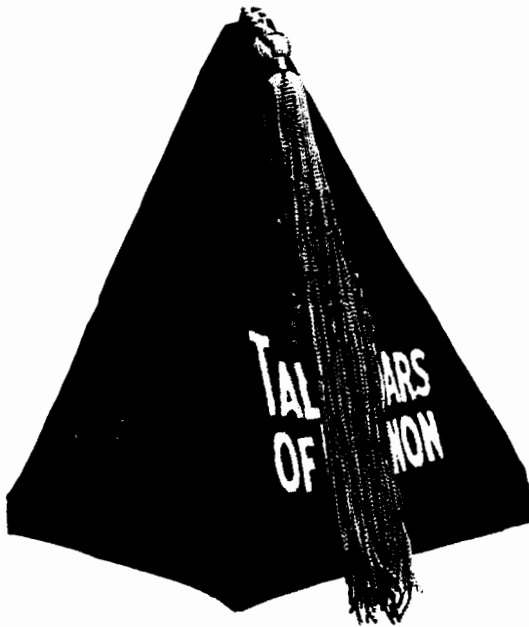

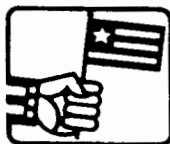
