Proposed Montgomery Forest By-Laws Change #1

As noted in the Grand Tall Cedar's message, the Forest Cedars and Cedarettes have agreed to move the meeting times to earlier in the day to the following schedule:

Dessert & Entertainment will be at **7:00pm**

Currently, ARTICLE VII (Meetings), Section a, reads:

The regular meetings of the Forest shall be held at 7:30 P.M. on the third Saturday of each month, except those months of July and August, which shall be in recess, in the place last designated by the Grand Tall Cedar.

At the February Forest meeting, a vote will be held to change this section to the following:

The regular meetings of the Forest shall be held on the third Saturday of each month, except those months of July and August, which shall be in recess, in the place last designated by the Grand Tall Cedar. The time of day of the regular meetings will be set by the Executive Committee and communicated to the membership through the newsletter.

Proposed Montgomery Forest By-Laws Change #2

Another change discussed by the Executive Committee is the exclusion of any new life members in the Forest. All current life members would be unaffected by this change.

Currently, ARTICLE X (Fees and Dues), Section f, reads:

Any member of the Forest in good standing may become a Life Member by paying a fee in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) or by having the same conferred upon him for outstanding, long, or by Conspicuous service to the Forest by two-thirds votes of the members present and voting at a regular meeting. In any event, the said sum shall be placed in the Life Membership Fund by the Trustees, with only the dividends therefrom being paid into the general fund of the Forest as the same accrue.

At the February Forest meeting, a vote will be held to change this section to the following:

No new Life Memberships will be offered. All existing Life Memberships will continue to be honored. The Life Membership Fund will be managed by the Trustees, with only the dividends therefrom being paid into the general fund of the Forest as the same accrue.

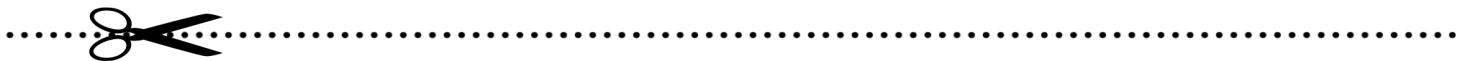
