Accordingly, Notice is hereby given that at its Stated Communication on Tuesday, June 8, 2010, at the hour of 6:00 p.m., in the Lodge Room, Second Floor, of the Scottish Rite Temple, 622 West Campbell Avenue, Roanoke, Virginia, 24016, the following Resolutions amending the By-laws of the Roanoke Scottish Rite Bodies will come before the membership for a vote. As stated in each set of By-laws, "At such meeting, if the majority of those present shall vote in the affirmative, the amendment shall be declared adopted, and shall become effective when approved by the Inspector General, or Deputy of the Supreme Council."

## Resolution

Be it RESOLVED, pursuant to Article VIII, Section 6 of the By-laws of the Roanoke Lodge of Perfection, that Article IV, Section 2, be amended as follows:

1. That the present amount for dues therein be deleted: and
2. That amount stated for dues therein be inserted as follows:

Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per annum for the calendar year 2011, plus such increase in Supreme Council per capita dues as may be imposed for each calendar year commencing in the year 2012.

Be it RESOLVED, pursuant to Article VII, of the By-laws of the Roanoke Chapter Knights Rose Croix, that Article IV, Section 2, be amended as follows:

1. That the present amount for dues therein be deleted: and
2. That amount stated for dues therein be inserted as follows:

Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per annum for the calendar year 2011, plus such increase in Supreme Council per capita dues as may be imposed for each calendar year commencing in the year 2012.

Be it RESOLVED, pursuant to Article VII, of the By-laws of the Roanoke Consistory, that Article IV, Section 2, be amended as follows:

1. That the present amount for dues therein be deleted: and
2. That amount stated for dues therein be inserted as follows:

Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per annum for the calendar year plus such increase in Supreme Council per capita dues as may be imposed for each calendar year thereafter commencing in the year 2012.

You may avoid future dues increases by obtaining a Life Membership in Perpetuity for:

55 years and under \$1200.00 56-64 \$1100.00 65+ \$900.00

If you are not current in your dues you must also pay that amount. You may in installments but if not paid by the end of the calendar year you will then have to pay the next year's dues also until the LMIP is paid in full.

Bro. Tabbert is the author of the book *American Freemasons: Three Centuries of Building Communities*, and has also published numerous articles and given many presentations and was a curator of several Masonic exhibitions.

Bro. Tabbert will speak on the differences of the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction and the Southern Jurisdiction of the Scottish Rite as well as the George Washington Masonic Memorial, its collections and its historical development.
