At our June meeting, the Temple is going to supply the chicken and drinks and we ask that everyone else bring a dish to share. The dress for this diner is casual. NO TIES!!

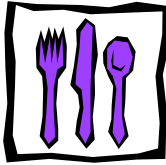
We need to keep in mind that we support children with learning disabilities through our Language Disorder Clinic at Radford University & as I have said before Autism is on the rise. So please keep up the support.
