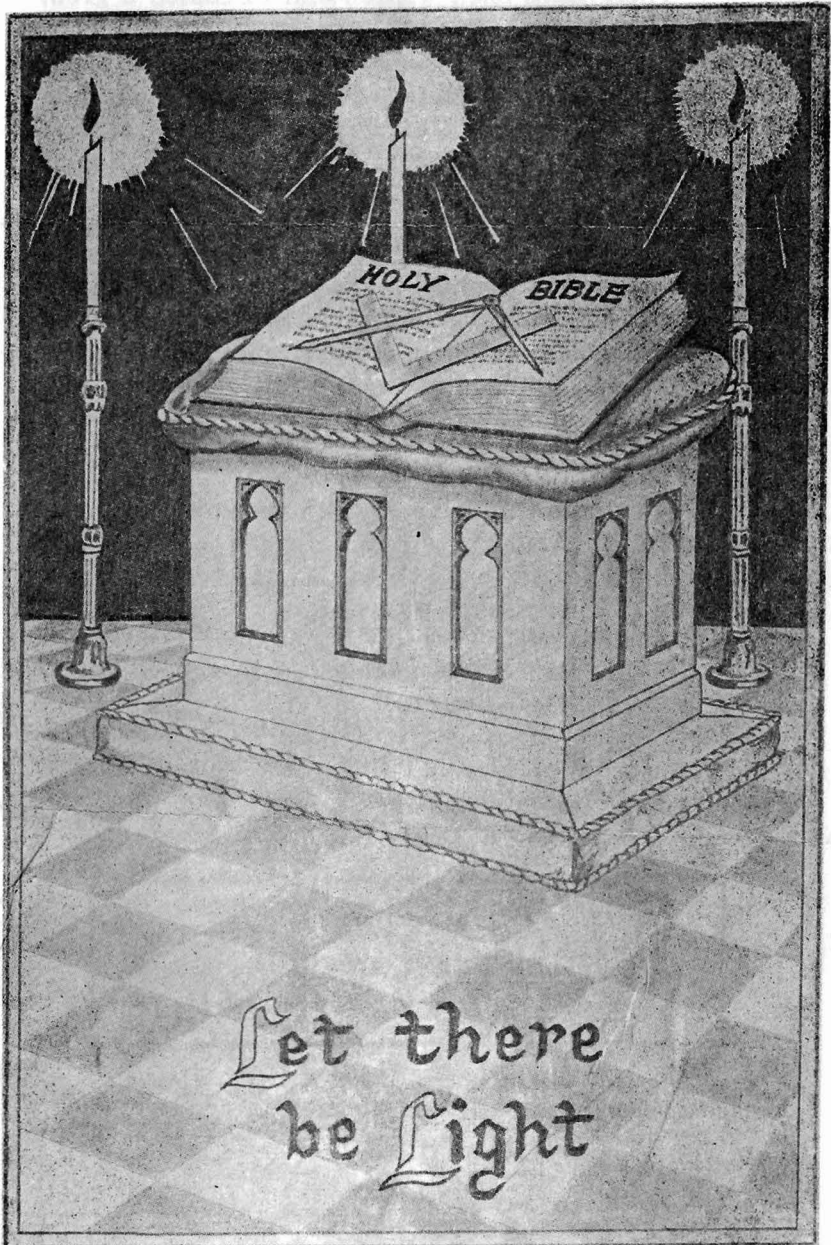

There have been written and discussed a great many definitions of Masonry. Recently, I read one in a Masonic publication which came from the German Handbook and Encyclopedia of Masonry published in 1900. It may be a little different in some respects from our own individual ideas, but it is a foundation of the universal understanding of what Masonry is.

“Masonry is the activity of closely united men, who, employing symbolical forms borrowed principally from the Mason’s trade and from architecture, work for the welfare of mankind, striving morally to ennoble themselves and others, thereby to bring about a universal league of mankind, which they aspire to exhibit even now on a small scale.”

How does this compare with your own idea of a definition for Masonry? Possibly yours is a little different; but I would guess that this one is as valid now as it was 71 years ago.
