We hear the Worshipful Master and Senior Warden say it in our opening and closing ritual, we all say it when asked where we are from, but do any of us know where it comes from. Maybe, this will shed a little light on the subject.

"SHEKINAH"

The Hebrew word derived from Shakan, meaning to dwell. A term applied by the Jews, especially in the Targums, to the divine glory which dwelt in the tabernacle and the Temple, and which was manifested by a visible cloud resting over the mercy-seat in the Holy of Holies. It first appeared over the Ark when Moses consecrated the Tabernacle; and was afterward, upon the consecration of the Temple by Solomon, translated thither, where it remained until the destruction of that building. The Shekinah disappeared after the destruction of the first Temple, and was not present in the second.

The Shekinah was the symbol of the Divine Glory, but the true glory of divinity is Truth, and Divine Truth is therefore the Shekinah of Freemasonry.
