
WORKING TOGETHER TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE



PURPOSE of Camp Kemo

To provide a normal camping experience for children with cancer and their siblings

SPONSORED BY:

Children's Center for Cancer and Blood Disorders of Palmetto Health Richland, Columbia, South Carolina

ELIGIBILITY:

Children who have or have had cancer between the ages of 5 and 18 years and siblings of children with cancer between the ages of 7 and 16 years, who receive their therapy at the Children's Center for Cancer and Blood Disorders of Palmetto Health Richland. (Once a patient has been off therapy for 3 years they are not allowed to bring a sibling; once a patient has been off therapy for 5 years they are no longer eligible to attend)

GOVERNED BY:

Thirteen council members composed of Children's Center for Cancer and Blood Disorder's staff and community leaders



No cost to campers - the operating cost is approximately \$500.00 per child.

WHAT IS CAMP KEMO

CAMP KEMO is a weeklong summer camp for patients with cancer, ages 5-18 and their siblings. Staffed by physicians, nurses and volunteers, CAMP KEMO allows campers to swim, boat, hike, and simply be children. The fun times at CAMP KEMO lay important groundwork for future treatment as participants learn to trust, respect and relate to one another. CAMP KEMO is funded completely by **community donations.**
