

International Order of the Rainbow for Girls Pledge Group for ages 6 – 10

What is a Pledge Girl?

A Rainbow Pledge is a girl between the ages of 6 and 10 who believes in God and would give service to her community and likes to have fun. It is hoped that when the girl reaches the age of eleven that she will want to become a Rainbow Girl.

What do Pledge Girls do?

Pledge girls have one business meeting a month to discuss what fun and service activities they would like to do. They learn about patriotism, respect, and how to socialize with others. Each pledge group plans their own activities, with the help of a Pledge Mother. The girls are also often invited to participate in the activities that the Rainbow Assembly has planned.

How are Pledge Girls supervised?

The Pledge Group is under the direction of the Pledge Mother (adult supervisor). The Pledge Sister is the president of the group (usually age 10).

Are there any costs involved?

No. The Pledge Group is sponsored and paid for by the local Rainbow Assembly. Membership fees are not collected; however, members may be required to bring money with them on various social outings.
